This month we received the good news that our budget has been confirmed for 2022, at the same level as 2021. We are still awaiting final confirmation on projects and activities from Tusla, but they will be under the themes agreed with the Consortium in our September meeting. These are:

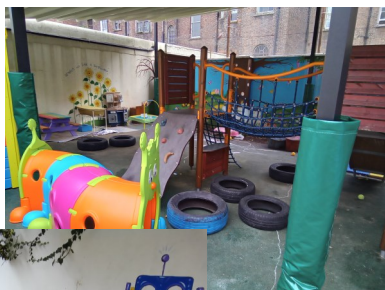
1. *Multidisciplinary Team*

ABC was able to provide outdoor gear and sensory resources to creches in the area, to enable children to play outside as part of their learning.

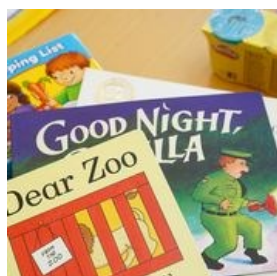

National Policy Framework for Children & Young People.

The next national policy framework for children and young people will run from 2023 to 2028. Together with previous strategies, the new strategy will aim to improve outcomes for children and young people living in Ireland.

Minister for Children, Equality, Disability, Integration and Youth, Roderic O’Gorman, T.D. announced the launch of a consultation seeking the public’s views on the next national policy framework for children and young people. This will involve government Departments working collaboratively with statutory agencies and services, and the community and voluntary sectors.

This is the first of a range of consultations that will be carried out in the design and development of this new policy framework and will help identify the key issues for children, young people and their families. It will help to guide further consultations over the development of the new policy. More information on this initiative can be found at:
