Minister O'Gorman announces €1,000,000 International Protection Integration Fund 2022

€1,000,000 will be made available to community based organisations for initiatives supporting the integration of International Protection Applicants.

Successful applicants stand to receive grants of up to €50,000 to carry out integration projects at national, provincial, or local levels throughout Ireland.

The Fund aims to enable community based organisations across Ireland to play a greater role in supporting the



integration of International Protection Applicants. Two funding streams will be available to organisations for both single and multi-county projects, awarding grants of €10,000 - €50,000.
